



SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND OUTLINES

Current Scholarships Available at Pioneer Village School:

- **2020 Learning Enrichment and Acceleration Scholarship (LEAP Scholarship)**

Academic Scholarships will be awarded to children of new families who will be entering into Years 3 or 4, 2020. These Scholarships offer part or full remission of tuition fees for the duration of the student's time at Pioneer Village School. Students will be selected on academic excellence based on the results from the Scholarship test sat in early May and a review of school reports, NAPLAN and similar supporting evidence. This Scholarship offers some half or full remission of tuition fees for the duration of the student's time at Pioneer Village School and is awarded at the discretion of the principal. Costs associated with the Scholarship are levies and resource fees, booklist items, purchase of the full school uniform and Year 6 camp, if applicable.

The following Scholarships will have prior academic success is taken into account if age applicable, but most importantly we are looking for students who have a positive attitude, a willingness to take on new challenges and a commitment to the Pioneer Village School values. Costs associated with the Scholarship are levy and resource fees, booklist items, purchase of the full school uniform and Year 6 camp, if applicable. These Scholarships offer either half or full remission of tuition fees for the duration of the student's time at Pioneer Village School and is awarded at the discretion of the principal.

- **Semester 2, 2019 Future Footprints Scholarship**

Pioneer Village School strongly believes that the Early Years' education is imperative in gaining a strong foundation. A strong foundation leads to a bright future and a love of learning. At Pioneer Village School, we would like to offer a Scholarship to new students, to start in any of the years from **PP to Year 3 in Semester 2, 2019**. This Scholarship offers half tuition remuneration.

- **2020 Pioneer Village School Humanitarian Scholarship (Visa Documentation-refugee status required)**

Pioneer Village School has strong school values and provides educational opportunities for a broad range of students. This Scholarship is aimed at those who would not normally have the means to attend the School. This Scholarship is open to all families with Visa documentation to support their refugee status. This Scholarship offers full tuition remuneration.

- **2020 Indigenous Australian Scholarship**

Students of Indigenous Australian descent may apply for this Scholarship. This Scholarship is for students wishing to start at Pioneer Village School in 2020. This Scholarship offers full tuition remuneration.

- **2020 Pioneer Village School Alumni Scholarship**

If you are a second generation to attend Pioneer Village School, you are welcome to apply for this Scholarship. We wish to celebrate families' ongoing loyalty and commitment to Pioneer Village School. We will ask for proof of this upon interview. This Scholarship offers half tuition remuneration.

PART 1- REGISTER INTEREST

PART 2 – PORTFOLIO SUBMISSION

Please compile an A4 sized portfolio. The purpose of the portfolio is to give the School an understanding of your child, including their academic and extra-curricular achievements, interests and goals. It is an integral part of the assessment process, and is considered in conjunction with examination results. The portfolio must include all items listed below, as well as any other supporting documentation that you may wish to submit.

Please ensure that you *do not include original documents*, as your portfolio will not be returned.

1. Print and complete the Pioneer Village School Enrolment Application Form and place at the beginning of the portfolio.
2. You will need to complete and sign the Pioneer Village School Scholarship Declaration.
3. Include a copy of your child's **two (2)** most recent school reports, if applicable.
4. Include NAPLAN results (if applicable).
5. Include a copy of your child's birth certificate.
6. Include a letter addressed to the Principal explaining the reasons why you seek the scholarship for your child, and how you will support your child to strive to uphold the school values at all times should they be awarded the Scholarship.

Applicants who do not include all items listed above or are late in submitting their portfolio may or may not be considered for a Scholarship and an incomplete or missing portfolio will form part of deliberations during the adjudication process.

PART 3- INTERVIEW AND TEST

Your child will be allocated a date and time to attend an interview and complete the required testing.

PART 4- SUCCESSFUL PARTICIPANTS NOTIFIED

If successful, you will receive a letter from the Principal outlining the relevant information and next step.
