



## **UNIFORM POLICY**

### **Aim**

The aim of the school uniform is to give a child a sense of belonging and pride in their school. It contributes to the maintenance of a positive school tone and promotes equity within the school environment.

### **Implementation**

The wearing of the school uniform is compulsory. On occasions when students arrive wearing incorrect uniform, parents may be contacted, and the child may be supplied with an appropriate uniform if available. All clothing must be labelled. Students are expected to be groomed according to this school uniform policy, dressed in correct school uniform, and maintain it in good condition.

- Parents are to send a Dojo Message to the teacher if your child is not in correct uniform for any reason.
- Dress and Sport uniforms are not to be mixed and matched.
- The PVS school bag is a compulsory item.
- Hats are compulsory and must be worn outside at school. We have a “No hat, no play” rule and students who have no hat will be asked to sit in a covered area during play times.

### **Dress Uniform**

- Dresses must be knee length.
- School shoes or flat sandals are the only appropriate daily footwear.
- Enclosed school shoes must be entirely black and kept neat.

### **Sports Uniform**

- Sports uniform is to be worn on designated sports days.
- Sport shoes are to be cross-trainer running shoes (sneakers). Coloured runners are acceptable. However, skate shoes, high top basketball-style shoes, alternative sport shoes to runners and those with built-in wheels, lights or other accessories are not to be worn.
- Students may wear house shirts or navy sports shirts on sport uniform days.

### **Appearance**

- Hair (below shoulder length) must be always tied back.

- Hair may only be temporarily dyed for special events such as sport carnivals, dress up days and special performances, and must be washed out for the following school day. Hair is not to be bleached or permanently coloured.
- All hair accessories must be navy blue.
- For safety reasons, earrings must be sleepers or studs.
- Wrist watches (no Smart watches) are the only permitted jewellery items. No necklaces, bracelets, rings, this helps our students play safely.
- Nail polish is not allowed.
- Make-up is not permitted.

**The Principal has discretion in all matters relating to the Student Dress Code.**
